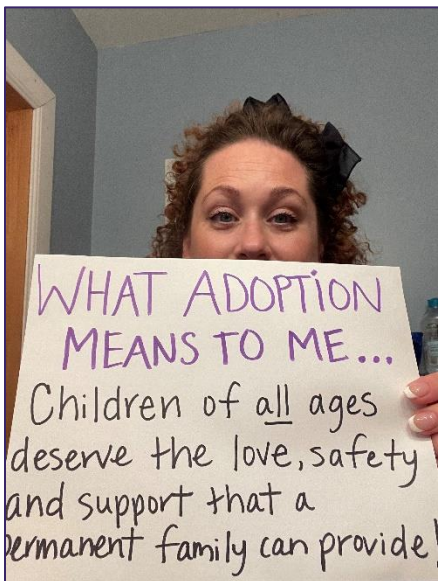


A Family for ME
