ACES Role of Experiences: Promoting Healthy and Thriving Students, Staff, and Schools (ACES 101)

Breakthrough research shows that adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) are linked to increased risks for physical, mental, emotional and behavioral health problems throughout life. This training will provide an introductory overview of the science of stress, ACEs and resilience. Participants will leave with strategies, tools and resources that support and promote resilience and well-being...

Fostering Resilient Environments: Working in Calm, Connected and Science-Informed Ways: Developing a Trauma-Informed Lens (ACES 102)

Preventing and healing ACEs is possible. No matter our age, there are science-informed ways to support resilience and recovery. Resilience and recovery can be fostered and developed during COVID-19. Participants will learn about the autonomic nervous system and how to shift from stress activation patterns to resilience-building ones.
